FAMILY SERVICES

Back2 School Store

A two-day event set up like a department store. Adult volunteers escort children as they select clothing and supplies in their favorite colors and styles, many receiving new items for the first time in their lives.

Court Advocacy

Trained volunteers help people in crisis negotiate the court system.

SIBS Place

Volunteers work at this South Nassau Communities Hospital program in Hewlett, as a free support group for children 5-17 years of age who have a seriously ill sibling or parent with cancer.

Sulam-Li

Volunteers with this program enable children with special needs to reach new heights in their Jewish education.

ADULT SERVICES

Center for Adult Life Enrichment (CALE)

Senior volunteers participate in new and exciting programs, classes and lectures.

Knitting Program

Volunteers knit and/or crochet unique lap and baby blankets which are donated to children's hospitals and wards.
